WORKING WITH THE CLINIC



- Must already be a business or plan on forming
- 14 week timeframe, pause for summer and school breaks
- Typical lawyer/client relationship
- Pro Bono, but you must pay for your own filings or applications if applicable
- You and your clinical law student determine your schedule
- The pace of the clinic can be slow
- You can return in future semesters without re-applying
- Either party can end representation
